

TM10 – Taikiti Bay™ (1 day)

Course description

This workshop is aimed at experiencing how to 'Create value through collaboration'.

Many companies face an increasing demand for inter-enterprise, intra enterprise and in situations such as mergers, alliances and strategic partnerships. Many face difficulties in making this form of 'working together' a reality - one that creates real, sustainable value.

Taikiti bay is a simulation in which participants play stakeholders of a tropical Island destination. The challenge is to meet the needs of Island investors whilst protecting the Islands culture and ecology, and providing infrastructure and employment to support the local population.

Taikiti bays' stakeholders must learn to work together to balance various stakeholder demands and create value for all.
